

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE:

PHYSICIANS MUST REGISTER WITH **NYSIIS** TO PROVIDE VACCINE TO PATIENTS

Here are some important updates from the Suffolk County Medical Society (SCMS) and the Medical Society of the State of New York (MSSNY).

1 ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

It is anticipated that the first supply of the COVID-19 vaccine will arrive in New York State in **December**.

For any Private Practice or Clinic to provide the COVID-19 vaccine to patients you **MUST BE ENROLLED** in the New York State Immunization Information System (NYSIIS). [CLICK HERE](#) for more information on NYSIIS and enrollment.

Enrollment for Ambulatory Care Providers opens on **December 21st**.
